5. Treasurer's Report – Amy Sullivan

Amy Sullivan, Treasurer, IARA provided an update on IARA's finances. Following up on old business, Don Clark did initiate a transfer of the 2 accounts he had overseen for IARA last year to AAAR. The funds got stuck in a hold. But AAAR did officially receive the funds in February 2020. AAAR opened a new checking account for IARA in November 2018. The account was opened with a transfer of funds from AAAR for what they owned IARA as host of the IAC in 2018, which was 3 times the amount of full registration. With the receiving of the funds from

Don's two account into the new IARA/AAAR account, as of June 30ththe balance is \$6013.36. We have continued with the plan that if IARA has an invoice to be paid, they send it to AAAR and the Treasurer approves it for payment. The only invoice since the last Board Meeting was for renewal of the IARA website in December 2019. The website was renewed for 3 years for \$323.64. It was also noted that AAAR has a new Executive Director, John Lessard. John is filling the role previously held by Bill Carney. Amy is also finishing her term as Treasurer following the AAAR Conference in October. Allison Aiken will be rotating in as the new Treasurer.
